The Annual Vail 'King of the Mountain' Open has a long, and rich, tradition with the Vail area that is going into its 39th year. The 2010 Event drew 414 teams including juniors and adult players alike. Approximately 1,200 people come to Vail over Father's Day Weekend directly associated with the Tourney. This includes players and their entourages and families as well. (The tourney has a large component of juniors players as well as family oriented co-ed and Father/Son and Father/Daughter divisions as well as adult divisions for masters/seniors and men's and women's rated divisions including open, A, BB, and B level competition.)

The timing of the tournament (Father's Day Weekend) allows the King of the Mountain to be the first BIG Event of the year for the Rocky Mountain Region outdoor volleyball season as well as "kicking-off" the opening of Vail's summer season.

Come on out and enjoy the Rocky Mountain Region's largest juniors beach doubles volleyball tournament. As well, participate in the FREE juniors doubles clinic which takes place on Friday afternoon, June 17th, from Noon until 4:30 p.m. This clinic is directed by USA Volleyball's Director of Special Events, John Kessel, and is coached by pro beach volleyball players. It is a fun afternoon that deals, primarily, with the differences between indoor six-man volleyball and the beach doubles game as well as showing you the basic strategies involved in playing doubles volleyball.

As well, some of you may want to play in our special Father's Day competitions of Father/Son and Father/Daughter (divisions related to the age of the daughter, or son: 12's, 14's, 16's, 18's).

Make a weekend of it: clinic on Friday, tournament on Saturday, and Father/Son & Father/Daughter on Sunday.
